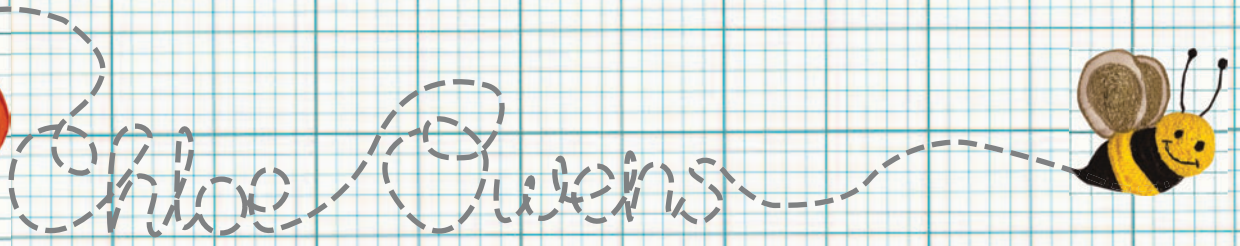




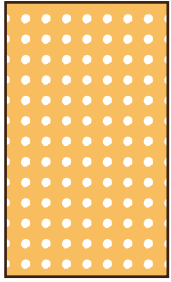

How to make Jake The Bunny

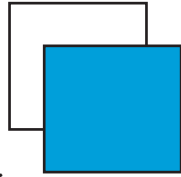


How to Make Jake the Bunny

1. Choose a fabric for the bunny's body.



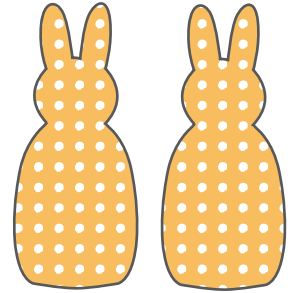
I have chosen an orange polka dot fabric.



Pick colour felts for the eyes and ears. (I have chosen blue & white).

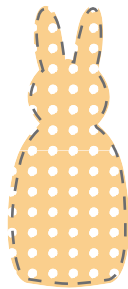
2. Cut the fabric patterns.

Trace patterns onto fabric and cut out carefully with scissors.



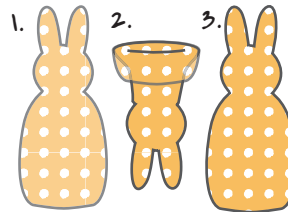
3. Pin & sew the body together.

Place the bunny's body right sides together and carefully pin in place.



Sew along the dotted line, leaving a 4cm opening at the bottom.

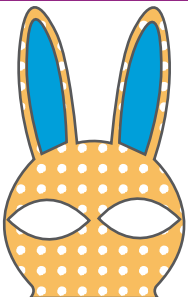
4. Turn the bunny's body right side out & stuff.



(Pulling the bunny through the bottom hole.)

Carefully stuff the bunny, taking special care with the ears. You can use a pencil to push stuffing into tight corners. Then hand stitch the hole at the bottom.

5. Now add the face!



Lightly glue the felt eyes & inner ears in place.

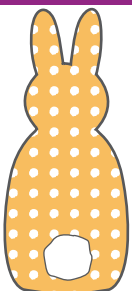
6. Carefully sew the inner ears, eyes & nose.



Add buttons for the eyes & sew eyelashes around each eye.

Sew on a nose & mouth with embroidery thread.

7. Add the tail & bow.



Roll the wool into a small ball for the tail & carefully sew onto the bunny's bottom.



Tie the ribbon around the bunny's neck into a bow.

8. Name & love your bunny!

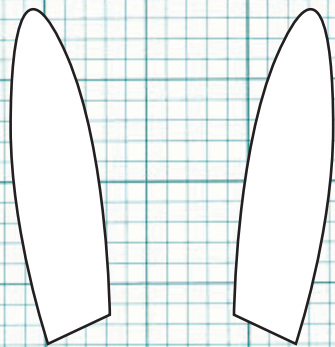
Mine's called JAKE!!

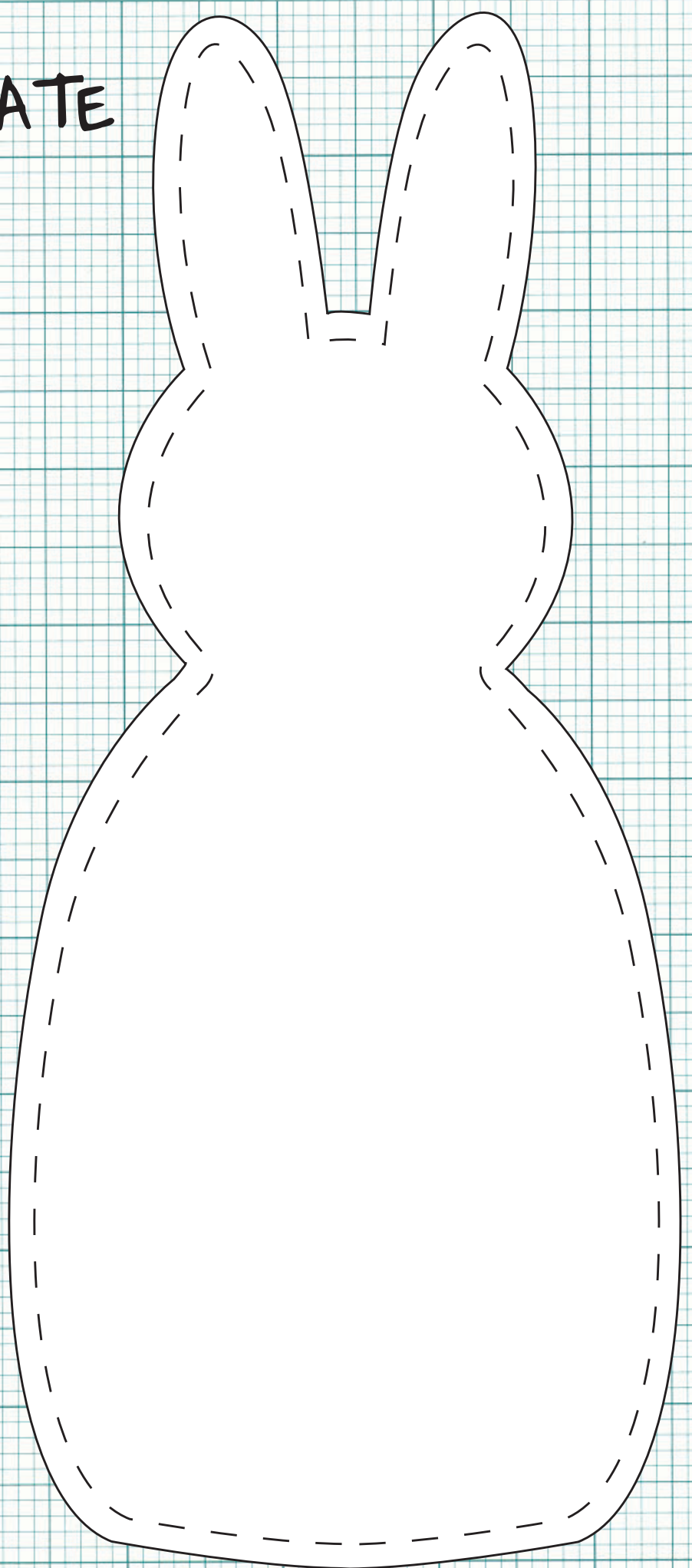
